## WHAT IS A SAFE SPOT ?

A Safe Spot is a safe and welcoming business, government or faith-based organization for students to visit if and when they feel unsafe on their way to and from school.

## HOW DO SAFE SPOTS WORK?

Students are encouraged to utilize Safe Spots if they feel they are being threatened, as a means to avoid confrontation, or if they need help after an incident has occurred.

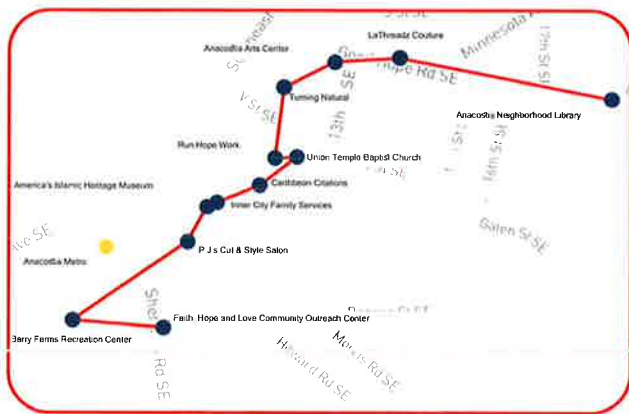
## HOW WILL STUDENTS KNOW IF A BUSINESS IS A SAFE SPOT?
